‘KARYASHALA’ scheme by DST SERB New Delhi is aimed to provide hands-on experience and lectures to the PG and PhD students primarily from universities, colleges, private academic institutions, and newly established institutes in handling/trouble shooting of high-end scientific instruments and skill development on themes required for research work.

ELIGIBILITY

The Workshop is to support regular PG level students and early stage PhD students who are having a strong orientation towards scientific research and are pursuing their degree from University/Institution within India (primarily from universities, colleges, private academic institutions) in the fields of Science and having an interest in scientific research. The event is only to support/train potential PG and PhD level students in their endeavors for pursuing a scientific career. This Karyashala is primarily for those who do not have the access to such esteemed research environment in their parent institution.

HOW TO APPLY

- The applicant should fill the online application form to apply using the link <https://forms.gle/G2qPoUyBk5CxsEVTA>
- The applicants must produce a letter of authentication from their Supervisor/Principal/Head and prepare a report to be submitted.
- A certificate regarding successful completion of Karyashala shall be issued to the candidates on satisfactory completion of the event and on submission of the assignment report.
- Candidates not completing the requisite period will not be issued any certificate.
- Lectures from Eminent Scientist from Various Research Institutes would be delivered in the Karyashala.
- Head of the Department / Head of the Institute indicating their association with the Institute and “No Objection Certificate (NOC)” for allowing their student to undergo Karyashala, if selected.

REGISTRATION FEE

There is no registration fee for the Workshop. But limited to **25 students** only. The selection of the eligible PG and early stage PhD students will be done based on the recommendations of the duly constituted Selection Committee. Hostel accommodation, food and travel by train will be provided to the candidates.
